## ADMISSION:

Admission to B.A / B.Com / B.Sc. First year Honours and General course will be strictly on the basis of merit. Students are provisionally admitted. Registration certificate will be issued to the candidate by the University of Gour Banga only after fulfillment of University norms.

### NORMS & PROCEDURE OF ADMISSION ARE AS FOLLOWS.

B.A / B. Com / B.SC Honours & General course are offered to the students who have passed the H.S Examination conducted by the WBCHSE or an examination recognized as equivalent by the University. The eligibility criteria as furnished by the University of Gour Banga to first year regular Honours course are

- 45% marks in the aggregate or
- 40% marks in the aggregate and 50% marks in subject.

Merit marks calculation formula:

**[Subject (opted for Honours) + Grand Total (Best of Five subjects excluding Envs.) /6  
English must be a subject of at least 100 marks in H.S/10+2**

In case any candidate opted for Honours beyond his/her subject combination at H.S. / (10+2) level, and for the students of the West Bengal State Council for vocational education & training, the merit lists for the Honours Courses will be prepared as:

**[0(zero) + Grand Total (best of Five)/ 6**

**N.B: Including English but excluding Environmental Studies.**

In the Final merit list of the candidates for different Honours department will be published on the College board as well as college are basis and the listed candidate are asked to appear on the notified date along with original mark sheet of the last qualifying Examination, Caste certificate and other requisite documents, if any, for counseling failing which they forfeit their claim for admission.

### SEAT DISTRIBUTION

The reservation policy of the Govt. of West Bengal (i.e. 22% for SC, 6% for ST, 10% for OBC – A, 7% for OBC – B and 3% for PH category) is strictly maintained at the time of admission and according to that seats are reserved as follows

- Note: - For optional / General subject seats are to be divided in 40:60 proportion among the Hons. and Pass candidates.
- For Physical Education the student must have Physical Education as a subject in 10+2 Exam or the student must have at least a District/ State/National/International level sports certificate.
- Reservation rules are followed according to Govt. Order.
- Subject combination for B.A Hons./General students is as follows :

One subject from each group is to be taken: Group A: Education/History

Group B : Bengali/English/Arabic

Group C: Pol.Sc/Sociology

There is no bar for rest of the optional subjects.

- Defence Studies is compulsory for students of Physical Education.
- Only Defence Studies can be taken by both Hons. and General candidates.
- For Economics Hons. Pass marks in (10+2) math is compulsory.
- For Geography pass minimum 60% marks in the subject is required.

**LIBRARY: -**

The college library is a well – equipped one with approximately 15,000 books. Though the number of books are still inadequate, the college is trying its level best to increase the number on regular basis. Regular book lending is done. We offer dailies, periodicals, journals and employment news in an academically conducive environment. The library is the academic hub of the institute. There is a separate reading room provision for Staff and the Students. the college is also a member of INFLIBNET for online access of journals for both teachers and students.

**CLASS ATTENDANCE:**

Students must attend classes regularly for appearing at the University Examination. The requirement of attending 75% of the classes held is mandatory for every examinee.

## SCHOLARSHIP STIPENDS AND GRANTS:

1. Applications of the S.C/S.T/Minority students are forwarded to the S.C/S.T/Minority and Backward class welfare dept. Malda for stipend.
2. Half free and full free studentship are awarded by the college to the poor and meritorious students selected by the college authority.
3. Applications of the students belonging to the BEEDI workers are forwarded to the labour welfare organization.
4. The students of the college can avail of the facilities of the students Health Home.
5. Grants for SC/ST/OBC (Non-creamy layer) and minority are determined on the basis of annual family income and merit.
6. Governments Scholarship from DPI ,Bikash Bhaban, is allotted to deserving students.
7. Beedi Scholarship is granted to students who are Beedi workers or whose parents are Beedi workers.
8. Minority scholarship is granted to students who have a low annual income and on the basis of merit.
9. Hazi Mahasin fund allots scholarship to poor and meritorious students.
10. The college receives grant on behalf of students from .N.G.O's like Zindal Foundation which is disbursed to the eligible students from time to time.
11. Kanyashree Scholarship is also provided.

**N. B.: Selection of students for conveyance allowance on the basis of attendance 75% attendances is essential for the students applying for any scholarship.**

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## **Rules and regulation of the college:**

1. Attendance at theoretical classes must be on and above 75%, Students only having requisite percentage will be allowed to appear in the college and University Exam. Submission of Medical Certificate against the inadequate percentage of attendance will not be considered.
2. Students are liable to be expelled for misbehavior and / or for adapting unfair means in examinations.
3. Students must come to the college with their identify card, so that on dement they can show that to the college authority.
4. Students must clear their college dues before commencement of their college exam.
5. No. students will be admitted to the Honours course unless he /she satisfy the University rules (for more information see admission).
6. Students' migrating from other boars or University must contact college office to regularize his / her admission.
7. Change of combination in the first year degree course may be allowed as per regulation of Gour Banga University, on payment of requisite fee, provided seats are available.
8. The medium of instruction in English and in Bengali.
9. Classes are normally held on and from 11.00 a.m... an Friday classes are suspended from 12.30 to 1.30 pm.
10. There shall be terminal exams, for first, second and third year students of both Hons. And Gen course. In these students have to secure certain marks to be eligible for the University Exam.
11. Students are required to look up at the college Notice- Board every days for all necessary information.
12. Students requiring certificates, documents etc. must submit their application at least seven working days before the date on which they want the same.
13. Without Library clearance students are not allowed to appear in the University Exam.
14. Use of Mobile Phone within the premises is restricted.
15. Students are expected to be disciplined in the college premises, that means.
  - i) They are responsible for good conduct in the college.
  - ii) They will not loiter or indulge in disorderly conduct in the college campus and library.
  - iii) They should be respectful to the Teacher and staff and helpful to the guests of the college.
  - iv) They must be regular in college and their respective classes.
  - v) They must not leave or enter the class room without permission of the teacher.
16. Ragging of any sort will not be tolerated in the college campus. Such cases will be investigated by the college authority. If anyone found guilty will be punished.
